

Ripton Vermont Route 125 Road Closure

The Vermont Agency of Transportation has issued the below road closure notice.

PROJECT LOCATION: Vermont Route 125 in Ripton, approximately 3.4 miles east of the intersection with U.S. Route 7.

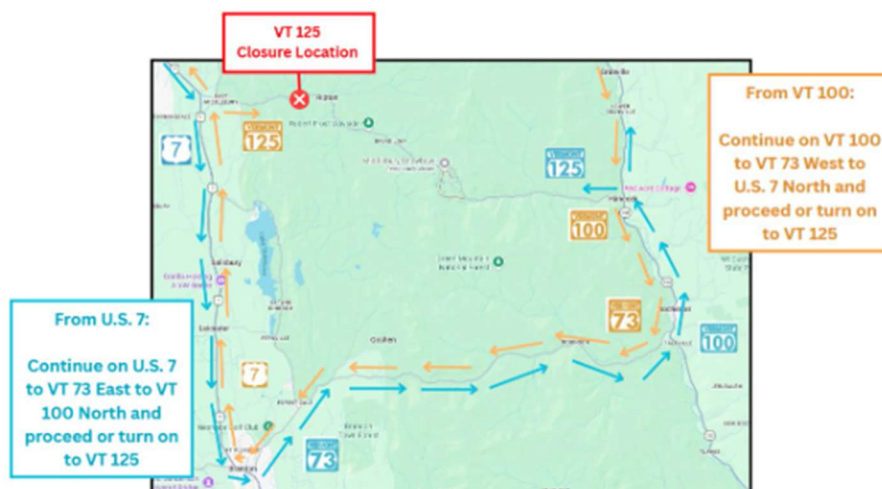
ROAD CLOSURE: Beginning MONDAY, JULY 27, 2026 at 7:00 AM, Route 125 will be closed to through traffic until FRIDAY, AUGUST 7, 2026. Route 125 will reopen at 6:00 PM on Friday, August 7, 2026.

DETOUR INFORMATION: A regional detour will be signed on U.S. Route 7, Vermont Route 73, and Vermont Route 100 during this 12-day closure period.

UPCOMING CLOSURE:

As a part of this project, there will be a 12 day closure of VT 125 at a location approximately 3.4 miles east of the intersection with U.S. Route 7.

The closure is planned to begin on July 27, 2026 at 7 a.m. and to be completed on or before August 7, 2026 at 6 p.m. A signed regional detour will be in place directing traffic on U.S. 7, VT 73, and VT 100. **Additional information/confirmation about the closure period will be distributed on Monday, July 13th.**
